

COVID-19 Safety Protocols

Concept Photography is committed to providing a safe and successful photo day. We have developed a safety plan to outline the policies, guidelines, and procedures we have put in place to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. The following protocols have been set in place in compliance with Work Safe BC and are broken down into the 4 levels of safety procedures they recommend.

Elimination

- A minimum distance of 10 feet will separate photographer from students and school staff at all times, including when students are being photographed.
- Non-adhesive rubberized floor markers will be placed to indicate safe social distancing and separation.
- Photo day station to be set up in the gym in order to provide adequate air flow, allow for proper social distancing, and to contain our staff to a controlled environment with outdoor entrance to reduce our presence within the school.
- Students to be photographed standing to eliminate the posing stool and reduce student to student contact.

Engineering Controls

- Clear safety barrier with camera hole cut out to be placed in front of photographer.

Administrative Controls

- A single entrance point, and a single exit point to allow for safe transport of students and staff in order to maintain safe social distancing.
- Student cohorts to be brought to the photo station one at a time with direct entry to the gym to eliminate hallway buildup.
- Outside gym doors to remain open to allow safe air flow and replenishment.
- Hand sanitizer provided to photographers.
- All orders to be placed online with direct ship to home in order to reduce handling and contact within the school.
- Increased cleaning protocols to sanitize and disinfect gear between schools.

PPE

- Face masks to be worn by photographers
- Education provided to workers to ensure they are being worn correctly.

Please note we will be closely following recommendations by our provincial health authorities and photography safety protocols may change based on new or revised recommendations. We will be monitoring our health closely and openly communicating if our staff develop any COVID-related symptoms.
